- *Indian Creek Country Club remains closed until further notice. Only essential Country Club staff members are allowed on the property;*
- *Medical calls will be appropriately screened by dispatch for COVID-19 symptoms and as a precaution, Police officers will remain on stand-by until Fire Rescue- Emergency Medical Service (EMS) arrives on the scene;*
- *Village Police officers will utilize gloves, masks and glasses as a protective measure, when necessary;*
- *Village Hall walk-ins can contact the main office line [\(305\) 865-4121](tel:3058654121), for further assistance;*
- *Building permit services remain operational and are being handled remotely; for further assistance, please contact the main office line [\(305\) 865-4121](tel:3058654121); and*
- *FPL has temporarily suspended non-emergency in-home and in-business visits;*

If you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, call the Florida Department of Health (FDOH) at [\(305\) 324-2400](tel:3053242400) and your physician.

- The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus - put 6 ft distance between yourself and other people;
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds;
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth;
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily; and
- If you get sick, CDC recommends that you stay home from work and limit contact with others to help stop the COVID-19 spread.

Also, Community Health of South Florida Inc. has begun a drive-thru testing site for COVID-19 in Miami-Dade County.

*Patients are asked to call [\(305\)252-4820](tel:3052524820) before coming to the center and will **ONLY** be tested if you meet the following criteria: recently traveled to any of the affected countries; have been in contact with someone who has the coronavirus; and/or if you are experiencing a fever, cough or shortness of breath.
