Potential Tropical Cyclone Nine- Update No. 1

Indian Creek Village Residents:

The Village is monitoring a potential Tropical Storm in the Atlantic Ocean approximately 585 ESE of the Leeward Islands, in the Atlantic Ocean.

At this point, it's being identified as Potential Tropical Cyclone Nine. Although, if this system continues to strengthen forecasters state it may potentially become a Tropical Storm during the next 48 hours and potentially be named Tropical Storm Isaias.

The current forecast places Miami-Dade County within the 5 day cone of uncertainty for a potential tropical cyclone.

Currently, **NO** watches or warnings have been issued for Miami-Dade County.
