Hurricane Isaias - Update No. 3

Indian Creek Village Residents:

The Village continues monitoring now a Category 1 Hurricane Isaias, about 350 miles southeast of Nassau, The Bahamas in the Caribbean Sea.

Village marine patrol services have been suspended starting noon today and will resume once weather conditions allow.

Current location: 20.9N / 73.3W (Approximately 550 miles SE of Miami-Dade County)

Maximum Sustained Wind Speed: 80 MPH

Forward Speed: 17 MPH

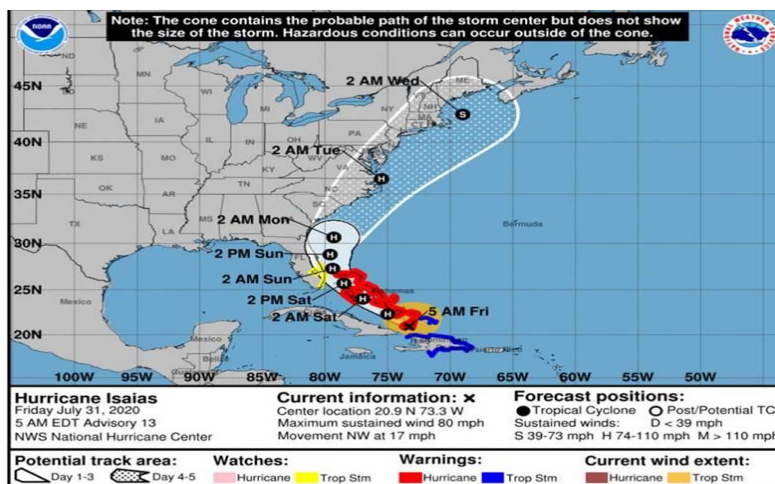
Forward Direction: NW

Potential for further development or weakening: On the forecast track, the center of Isaias will move near or over the Southeastern Bahamas today. Isaias is forecast to be near the Central Bahamas tonight and move near or over the Northwestern Bahamas and near or east of the Florida peninsula on Saturday and Sunday. Some strengthening is possible today, and Isaias is expected to remain a hurricane for the next few days.

Potential Impact for Miami-Dade County: Tropical storm conditions are possible (10-20%) for portions of the County [beginning on Friday night](#). Rainfall amounts are forecast between 3-4" with greater localized amounts.

Current related watches and warnings for Miami-Dade County: A Tropical Storm Watch is in effect for coastal Miami-Dade County.
