COVID-19 Update #21-COVID-19 Vaccine

Indian Creek Village Residents:

Miami-Dade County (MDC) is coordinating closely with hospital and healthcare partners, the Florida Department of Health, municipalities, and private partners to vaccinate members of our community against the coronavirus (COVID-19) as quickly and efficiently as possible.

According to State guidelines, the top priority for vaccination - following long-term care residents and staff and frontline healthcare workers - are Miami-Dade County residents age 65 and older.

**MDC will be opening a limited number of vaccine appointments for seniors 65 and older available for online scheduling starting today, Thursday, January 7 at 2 p.m.**

**It is expected all those slots to fill up very quickly based on the current demand and MDC is working to add new appointments as additional vaccines become available.**

- Miami-Dade County will provide vaccines directly to homebound seniors age 65 and older who live in County facilities or receive County services and wish to be vaccinated.
- Miami-Dade County staff are directly contacting these individuals to schedule vaccinations as of Monday, January 4.

### **Mount Sinai Medical Center**

Mount Sinai Medical Center is providing vaccines to Miami-Dade County first responders and individuals who are 75 years or older.
